Older Tudor Style home. The clients put in a pool and wanted a fun English style perennial garden to go in that would complement the style of their home. It was important that the garden would be easy to maintain and look interesting year-round. Tough perennials were chosen along with Iris and Alstroemeria bulbs. An old tired rose garden was refurbished and several cutting flowers were added. A Podocarpus gracillior hedge was added to help screen the driveway. One Pyrus kawakamii was planted to give the garden a nice focal point at the end of the planting area. Various vines (Banks rose, Petrea vine, Mandevilla, Wisteria and Passiflora) were planted on the house to conceal drain pipes and the condenser as well and soften the exterior of the house.
